

Community Standards UnboundedPeople

We'd like to wish you a warm welcome to our Community. Everyone should feel at home here. This can only happen if we interact positively with each other. So we've set up a few rules to create the right atmosphere.

Please follow them!

- You can only have one profile.
- You must enter your passport details as they appear on your passport and as completely as possible.
- You can use a standard icon as a profile picture, but your own profile picture is better.
- You can visit the travel community and browse but it's better if you actively participate as a U-Member. The more active you are, the faster you'll increase your ranking.
- You can fill in your own U-World (truthfully), but it's better if you fill in the U-World as completely as possible using the U-Lists.
- You should treat each another with respect, also when you're chatting. Basically: provocation, discrimination, swearing, racism, messages with sexual overtones or other shocking or undesirable behaviour is not permitted. This is not conducive to a positive atmosphere.
- Are you flouting the rules? And are you continuing to do so after UnboundedPeople has explained our preferences? Then we can delete your message. Are you ignoring successive warnings? Then we can remove your profile.

U-List

- If you're searching for information on a certain place, it's best to use the search bar. That way you'll know if U-Lists have already been created for the place you're searching for.
- Try to post your U-Lists in the correct category so they can easily be categorised. UnboundedPeople can move a message or an idea.
- Specific items can only be posted once. UnboundedPeople will remove duplicate items.
- Clearly state the name/title of your item and add an address if applicable. This will help others to easily find the location of the item.
- Make sure your descriptions and reviews are reader-friendly. Be mindful of whether an abundance of capital letters, abbreviations, punctuation marks or emoticons are pleasant for others to read.
- It is not compulsory, but you should make it a habit to rank a U-List item. This is better for those who have posted the item and also useful for others.

U-Chat

- You can send private messages to other U-Members for direct contact.

- You can send any U-Member a private message. They will decide, the same as you, whether or not to respond.
- You are able to receive private messages from UnboundedPeople. We will do this if we need your information to help you further.
- Have you received an inappropriate private message? Then report it by clicking on the 'Report Inappropriate Content' button. UnboundedPeople will take further action if necessary.
- You can participate in the U-Chat that is split into different countries/places.
- You can add a new U-Chat if no other U-Chat of a similar nature exists.

U-Stories

- If you're searching for information on a certain place/profile, it's best to use the search bar. That way you'll know if the subject already exists within the Community.
- Try to post your U-Stories in the correct category and add the right theme to your story. UnboundedPeople can move a message or an idea.
- Post a story or response once only. UnboundedPeople will remove duplicate messages or responses.
- You are responsible for your own story or response; other U-Members or UnboundedPeople are not.
- Clearly state the title of your story and add a matching photo. This ensures that others will easily understand what the story is about.
- Don't post private details in stories or responses. If UnboundedPeople requests your details, we will always do this in a private message. If another U-Member requests your private details, then send them a private message.
- You are responsible for reader-friendly stories and responses. Be mindful of whether an abundance of capital letters, abbreviations, punctuation marks or emoticons are pleasant for others to read.
- Don't post any commercial statements or questionnaires on U-stories.
- It's not compulsory, but you should make it a habit to rank a story that inspires you. This is better for members who've written the story and also useful for others.
- Do you think a story or response is inappropriate? Then report it in the story or response by clicking on 'Options' and then selecting 'Report inappropriate content'. Follow up by explaining why you consider it inappropriate. Make your explanation as detailed as possible. UnboundedPeople will review it and take action if necessary.

Ongoing insight

These rules are intended as a guideline for positive interaction. If this is not possible using the above rules, we are entitled to change them at our discretion.
