

Privacy Statement

What is personal data?

Personal data includes information such as your name, address, date of birth, telephone number, e-mail address and biometric data. We ask you to provide this type of information when you complete a form or send a letter or e-mail. In certain cases, you also provide us with personal data when you visit the UnboundedPeople website. Examples of this are your IP address or cookies.

Whose personal data do we use?

We can use the information of any individual we contact or who visits the UnboundedPeople website. UnboundedPeople also uses the personal data of individuals who are not U-Members of UnboundedPeople.

How do we use your personal data?

UnboundedPeople uses your personal data for the purpose of efficient and effective business management and in particular within the scope of performing the following activities:

- We use the personal data of our clients for internal analyses and product development. This helps us improve our products and services for our clients.
- To facilitate the performance of marketing activities, we use the personal data of existing and prospective clients, such as address details, e-mail address and your visit to our webpages. On the basis of information from internal and external sources and your visit to our webpage, UnboundedPeople is able to make suitable, tailor-made commercial offers through newsletters, for example.

How do we handle your personal data?

Carefully, securely and confidentially. That is how we handle your personal data.

Secure

Your personal data is in good hands at UnboundedPeople. UnboundedPeople ensures that your information is secure.

Confidential

All our employees have signed a non-disclosure agreement. This means that they handle the data you entrust to us with the utmost care. Only authorised personnel may process your data.

Cookies

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small data file that is stored on your computer when you visit a website for the first time. Cookies can be set and read by UnboundedPeople. Cookies save you from repeatedly entering certain information when you revisit a website. Different types of cookies exist, such as “session cookies” and “permanent cookies”. Session cookies are deleted from your computer as soon as you close your web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox or Safari are examples). Permanent cookies remain on your computer, even after closing your web browser. Each time you revisit using this computer, tablet or mobile phone, the cookie is recognized.

Why does UnboundedPeople use cookies?

UnboundedPeople uses both session and permanent cookies. Cookies help us to see which pages you have visited on UnboundedPeople. When we make you a special offer on our website, cookies help us to take your interests into account. You can configure your own cookie settings; on a custom level, personally or completely. Using cookies also helps UnboundedPeople to optimise our websites and make them more user-friendly.

Is it possible to block cookies?

Yes, you can block cookies on your computer. This can be done by using the privacy settings for your web browser. All cookies from any website that you visit will then be blocked. Websites may load more slowly as a result or even fail to load. Also, log in details will not be remembered.
